QUARTERLY COMMENTARY

- Healthcare M&A continues at breakneck speeds, with total corporate deal value up over 20% since Q1. Scott-Macon expects this to be a record year in both the number of transactions and in the size of transactions completed
- Healthcare is dominating one of the hottest IPO markets in history increasing the number of well capitalized, cash flush buyers with sky high growth expectations
 - The first half of 2021 had over 100 healthcare IPOs raising over \$28 billion which is a 50%+ increase from last year.
 - Many of these companies are trading at extraordinary valuations and may use M&A to fill these big shoes. Some examples include; A. Doximity (\$13.5B Market Cap; 54x Revenue), a social network for doctors; B. Butterfly Network (\$2B Market Cap; 242x Revenue), a disruptive ultrasound technology; C. FIGS Inc. (\$6.6B Market Cap; 16x Revenue), an apparel company for doctors and nurses.
- Provider consolidation speeds up, driven by a changing healthcare ecosystem that continues to shift toward outpatient, pricetransparent, value-based care
 - Unified Women's Healthcare acquires CCRM Fertility: expands their continuum of care into fertility, creating a one stop shop for women's health
 - Akumin acquires Alliance Healthcare Services: expands oncology capabilities in order to drive increased access and efficiency of care for patients.
- Healthcare IT M&A activity outperforms 2020 both in volume of deals and in deal size
 - Staffing constraints and the challenges posed by Covid-19 have forced providers to seek out tech-enabled solutions to improve productivity and meet demand




- Q2 deal volume continues to accelerate, up over 100% in deal value YOY, and increasing beyond Q1 levels
